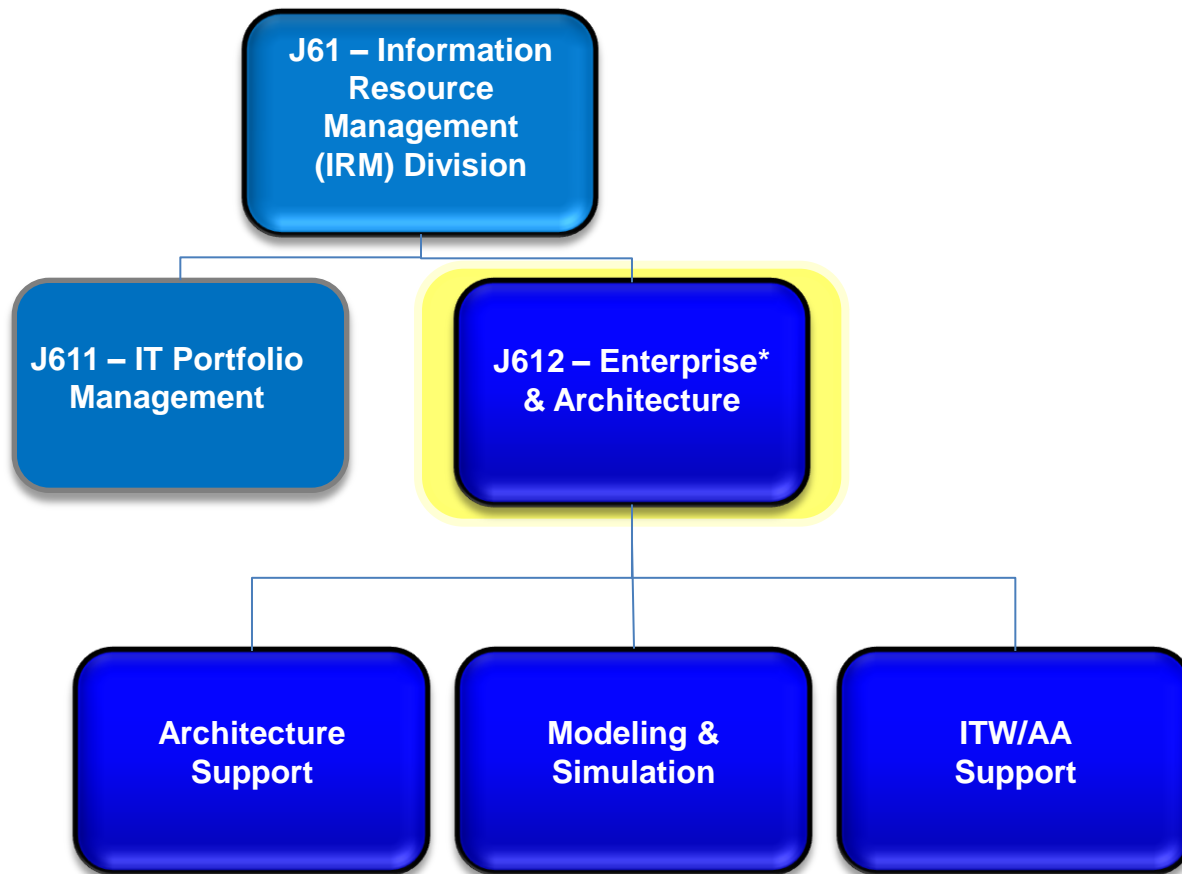


IRM Architecture Background

- **USSTRATCOM Architecture**
 - Function disbanded in Jun 2008
 - Function restored Feb 2009
 - MVB March 2009 established 15 architects
 - Training architects on-going
 - Embracing DODAF 2.0 Architectural Format

IRM Architecture Major Efforts

- **Command and Control Enterprise Integrated Process Team**
 - Formal processes to define C2 Enterprise
 - Strategies for capability gap identification
 - DOTMLPF solutions
- **CFTF**
 - Documented NC3 roles, responsibilities, and required capabilities



IRM Architecture Major Efforts

- **USSTRATCOM C4ISR Handbook**
 - Re-establish the documentation of current mission areas, systems, nodes, and, connectivity assessment information
- **Joint C2 Architectures and Capability Assessment Enterprise Implementation**
 - Collaborating with JFCOM for implementing JACAE as our primary architecture artifacts development tool
