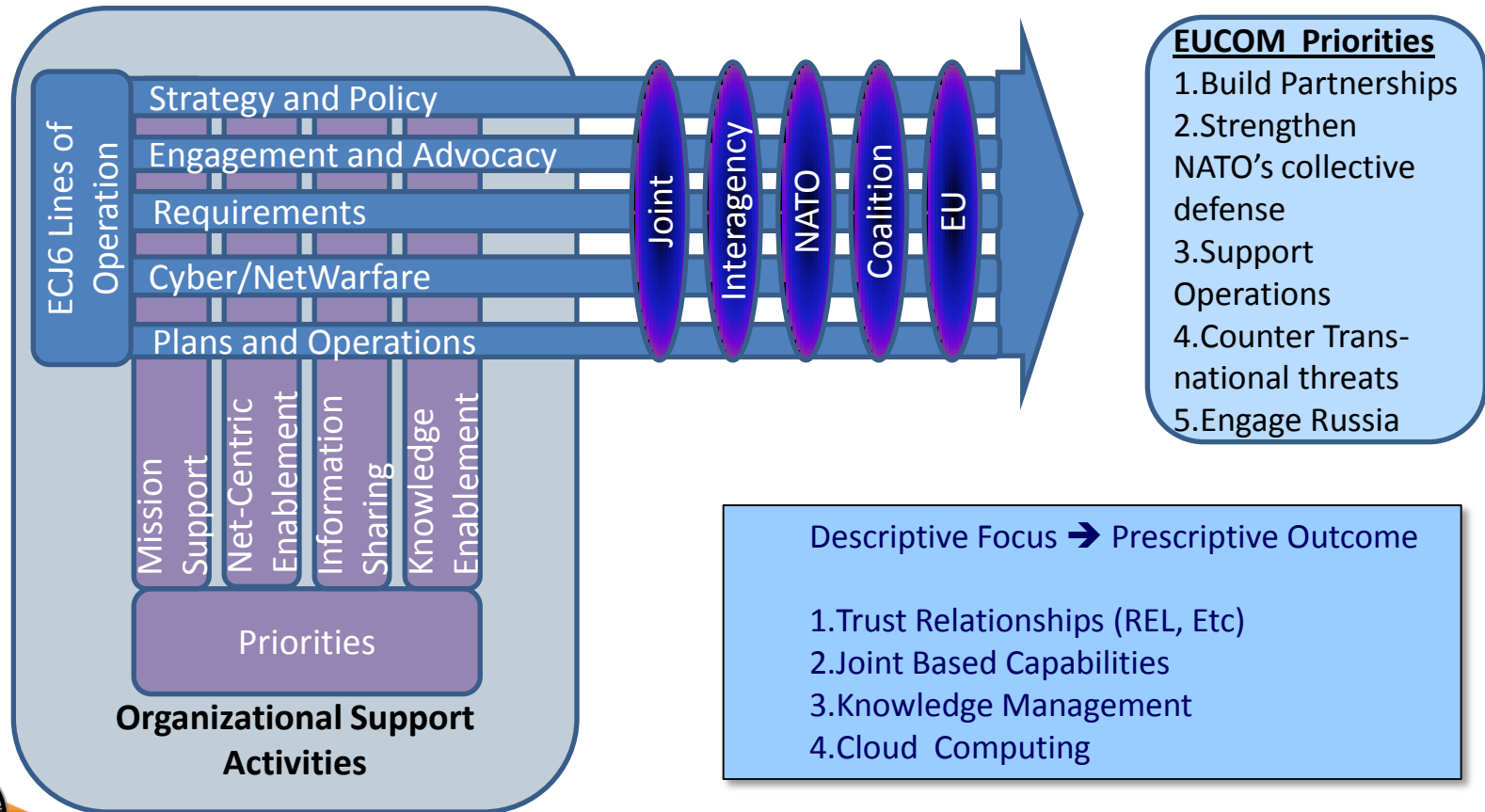

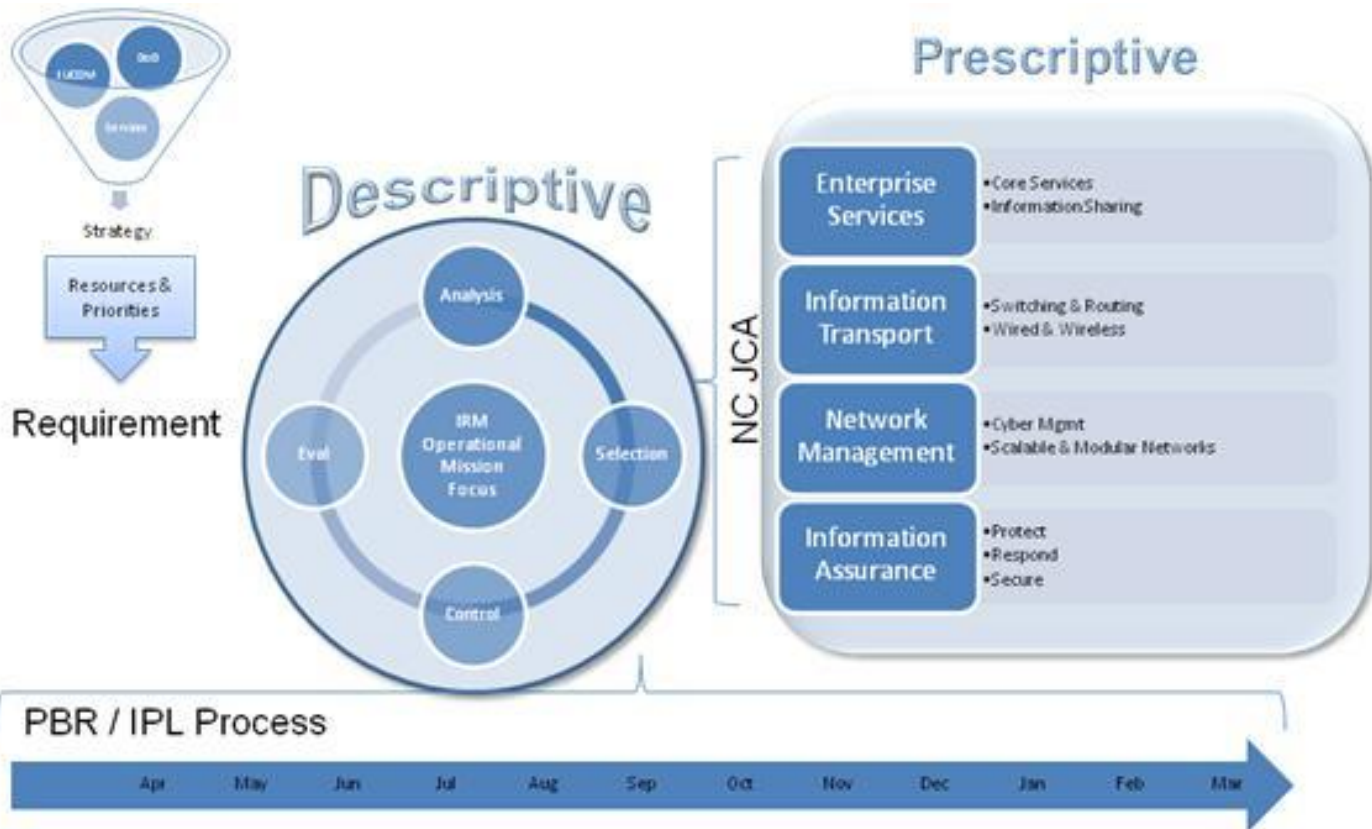
# Current Efforts

**VISION:** “Premier Communicators, Automators, and Network Operators providing full-spectrum cyber capabilities for the European Command Area of Responsibility”

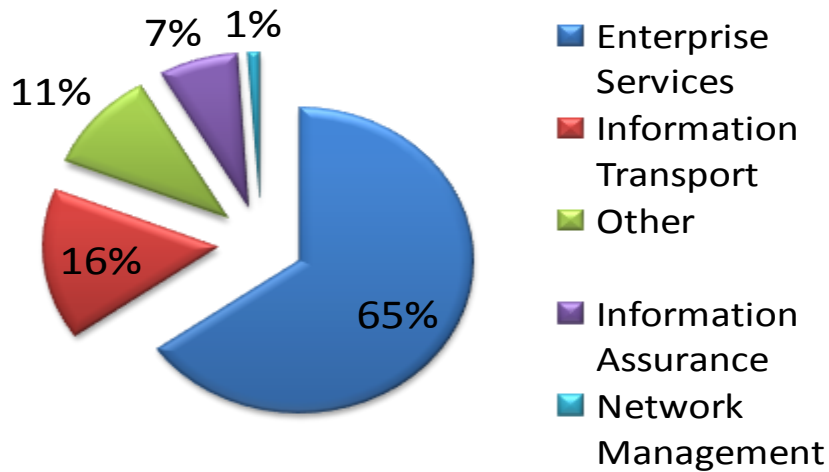

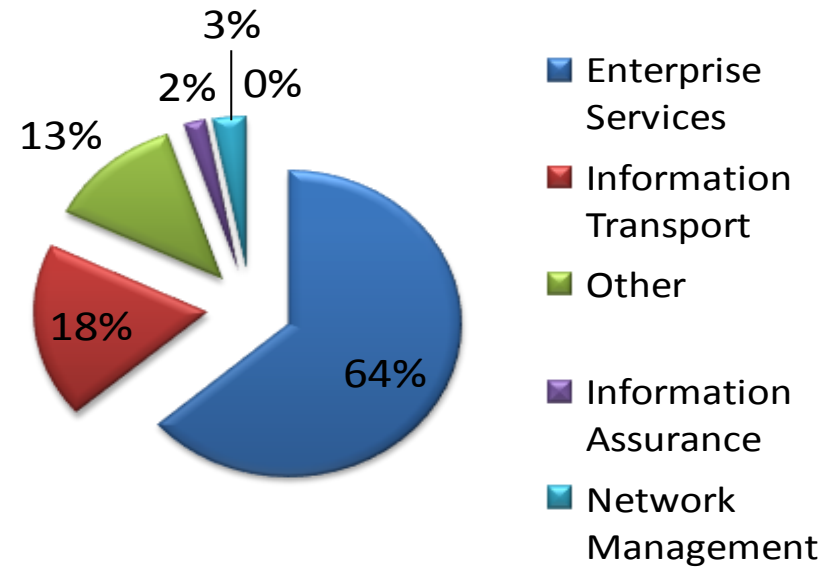
